Tuesday and Thursday flight training will resume in April 2016

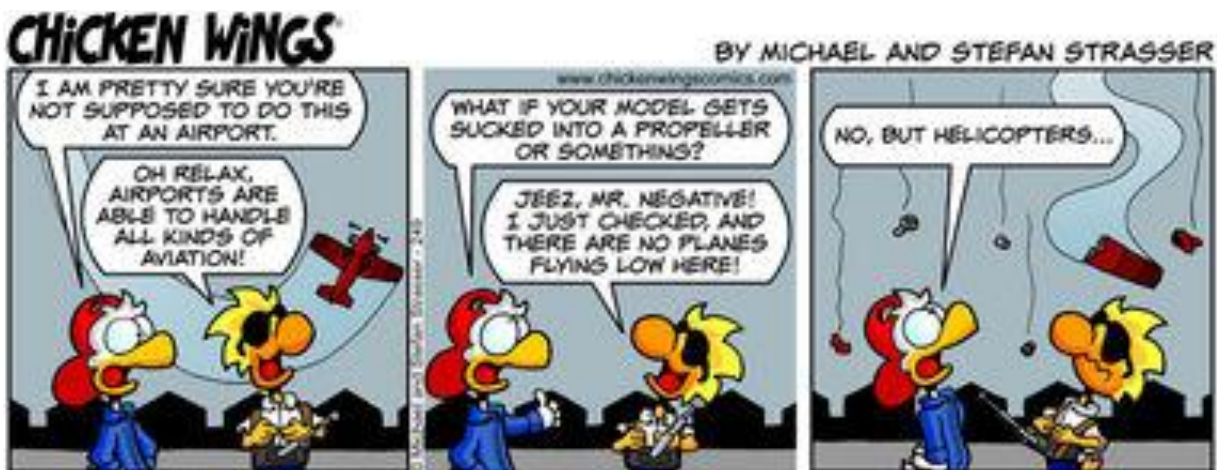
RCSF monthly meetings will be held at the flying field starting May 2016
